staff for the entire Legislature, and they are there to work for you, and they are there to answer your questions as well. And so, if you have any...I guess the main thing we want to do on Tuesday and Wednesday...Wednesday of next week is really try and answer the questions you develop over the weekend. And senators will be allowed...we would encourage senators to come to those work sessions on those two nights, next week, and ask questions in a public setting. It is our attempt to do this, instead of...given our time constraint and the weightiness of issues in front of us, besides budget, we do not want to spend the time explaining the budget on the floor. We will...basically want you to read the books and we will answer those questions and do what explanation is necessary on the two evening sessions, or late afternoon sessions next week. And so...cause this is just the small book here today, tomorrow you will have a larger book, that will have the different agencies. We encourage you to go through that, ask any questions you have over the weekend and also in those two work sessions next week, before we begin debating the bills on Thursday. Another thing I might add is if...I obviously cannot force any of you to do anything you do not want to do, but it would sure be my strong suggestion, when you have amendments to any of the budget bills, if you could go to the fiscal office and have them draft those amendments with you and for you, and obviously that will be done confidentially. The reason I ask that is it helps us if we can get those amendments drafted technically correct, and so when we go on in the process we don't have to clean those things up later. If you work with us in the beginning, you know, whether or not you agree with me on the policy, whatever we do, if you work with the fiscal office and have those amendments drafted...have us help you draft them, it would be greatly appreciated. Obviously, there will be floor amendments. And you know with those floor amendments, if you...I think the fiscal office will be camped out over here, move down a couple rings from Senator Warner I guess, they'll probably be over here, as those floor amendments come up we would strongly encourage you, if you want to only, if you would work with the fiscal office to draft those amendments, so we can get them drafted correctly, and so you don't have a couple extra zero's in there or anything like that. And so, with that, I think there's some motions on some bill introductions then.
