Appropriations, would move for the introduction of request number 1261.

SPEAKER BAACK: Senator Moore.

SENATOR MOORE: Yes, Mr. Speaker, this is request number 1261. I have a packet of committee statement of intents that are passed out. They are issues...the Appropriations Committee is introducing bills. This will be a 30...since this is not necessarily a pure appropriation bill, we are asking for a 30-vote rule suspension to introduce the bill. The first one is 1261, which would raise the commercial drivers license fee from 20 to 40 dollars, and this is the introduction of the bill, and we can debate it, hopefully, at a later time. This is just to get the bill introduced. It's request 1261, which raises the CDL fee from 20 to 40 dollars.

SPEAKER BAACK: Is there anyone wishing to discuss this motion? If not, we will proceed to vote on the motion to suspend the rules for bill introduction. All those in favor vote aye, opposed vote no. This motion does require 30 votes. Record, Mr. Clerk.

CLERK: 31 ayes, 1 nay, Mr. President, on the introduction of a new bill.

SPEAKER BAACK: Motion is carried.

CLERK. Mr. President, LB 854, introduced by Appropriations Committee. (Read by title for the first time. See page 1911 of the Legislative Journal.)

Mr. President, Senator Moore, as Chair of Appropriations, would move for the introduction of request 1239.

SPEAKER BAACK: Senator Moore.

SENATOR MOORE: Mr. Speaker, this is the second page of request 1239, in which we raise the teacher certification fee from \$25 to \$50 and will change the mix as outlined in the statement of intent. Thirty-two dollars of the \$50 fee would go to the Teacher Certification administration, and \$18 would go to the Professional Practices Commission. This is, once again, just the motion to introduce the bill. Debate it now, would prefer to debate it on General File then.
