SENATOR WITHEM: Okay, then...and I'm not so sure I will, I'm just asking process questions. Long as I have you on the mike, and I have time here, let me ask you the other question, and that is your motions for bill introduction are going to be limited to these four and the mainline budget bill, and the other budget bills will be dealt with in bills that are referred from the committee, and committee amendments will be dealt...appropriation changes from the original...Tell me about the mainline budget bill. Is that going to be one of these that's going to be introduced here directly to General File, or will the mainline budget bill be using a different process?

SENATOR MOORE: No, if you look at the one-page sheet that has appropriation bills, committee recommendation and total, I don't know if you have that. The four issues we're talking about now are the four new bills.

SENATOR WITHEM: Okay.

SENATOR MOORE: All the other ones are...were existing bills that, with the exception of the legislative salaries, which...there's no amendment, will be committed like the mainline bill. We are amending LB 843, the Governor's bill,...

SENATOR WITHEM: Okay.

SENATOR MOORE: ...that was drafted in the form of a committee amendment, amendment 1508, that has been introduced. And so we do not need any sort of rule suspension to do that, that will just be a committee amendment that has been filed.
