SENATOR MOORE: Yeah.

SENATOR WITHEM: Okay, thank you very much.

SPEAKER BAACK: Thank you, Senator Withem. Senator Lamb, did you wish to discuss this?

SENATOR LAMB: Yes, Mr. Speaker and members, my concerns parallel those expressed by Senator Withem, and particularly the first is a bill that's already been introduced having to do with the commercial driver license fee, and primarily because we just passed that bill not very long ago. And I guess the implied promise was that the fee was going to be 20 dollars. And then just as soon as we get our bill passed then we come back around and say, no, I'm sorry, we made a little error, we're going to double the fee. We had a lot of discussion about that before that commercial drivers license bill was passed. We were assured by agency people that the \$20 was sufficient, and so I just don't like the process that we sometimes get ourselves into, and I think we are on this...that particular bill, which I know I'm out of order, because it's already been introduced. But that's my concern, because had I not been detained, unnecessarily in my office, I would have said this when I was not out of order. But that's the concern I have then, especially since we're not going to have a public hearing on this, when we have...we're just saying, hey, we shanghaied you folks and now we're going to change the rules. And I have real reservations about the process.

SPEAKER BAACK: Thank you, Senator Lamb. Senator Haberman, did you wish to...Seeing no other discussion, we will now vote on this motion. All those in favor vote aye, opposed vote no. This motion does require 30 votes. Have you all voted? Have you all voted? Have you all voted? Senator Moore.

SENATOR MOORE: I'm thinking...it's 20...I need 30 votes to make this. Is there anybody here that could still vote? I see Senator Horgan looking back towards that. He'll probably vote no, and that won't help me any. He did vote no, and...now Senator Elmer's changed his vote. I still need one more for this, if I don't have a call of the house, and if anybody is in the back room...I guess, in the interest of time, if we could...I'd ask for a call of the house, accept call ins...oh,
