is I request a division of the question, having request 1261 and 1239 be treated as one motion, and request 1271 and 12...or 1186 be treated as a second motion. I don't know if these are no longer requests, or they are now real, live bills that they've been introduced, and I don't know the bill numbers. But my request would be that the Cash Reserve Fund, \$5 million transfer, and the \$180 per day, Commission of Industrial Relations, be treated as one motion; and then the two motions increasing the fees be treated as a different motion.

SPEAKER BAACK: Senator Moore will simply withdraw his motion, and then offer each one individually, and that would be easier, procedurally, to go ahead and do it that way. Is that acceptable? Is that acceptable, Senator Withem?

SENATOR WITHEM: Yeah, that's fine.

SENATOR MOORE: The reason I do that is because there's a rule says you cannot divide a rule suspension, so that would make it more easier to do it that way. (Microphone turned off momentarily.) ...motion on the fees, the second motion would be the other two bills.

CLERK: So, Senator, just so you and I are clear, we'll do request 1261 and 1239 together, is that right?

SENATOR MOORE: Yes.

CLERK: Okay. And then do 1271 and 1186 together, is that right?

SENATOR MOORE: Yes.

CLERK: Okay. Yes, sir. Mr. President, the first motion then before the Legislature is to suspend the pertinent rules and place LBs 854 and LB 855 directly on General File.

SPEAKER BAACK: Senator Moore.

SENATOR MOORE: Maybe, if I quit speaking so clear and start mumbling, this will be a little easier for all of us. (Laughter.) This is the motion...these two bills are the two fee things I think we've had questions about, the commercial drivers license bill...fee, and the teachers certification fee.
