It says, "You, too, can, in fact, with this incredible Big Five plan, your chances are five times better to win the big bucks. I was limited to the state where I lived. Now, regardless of where you live, you have the opportunity to hold the winning tickets in California, Florida, Illinois, Pennsylvania, and New York, the five richest lottos in the country. That makes your odds five times better than just playing a single state." They also send you a scratch card. If you scratch one of the blocks that they show here, you could win a trip to Rio, Hawaii, or Mexico, but when you scratch that one box off, and if you are a winner, then you have to send in your subscription to...I think it is in Vancouver, Canada, and I asked at several groups in Omaha, when I am speaking to different groups, mainly, the senior citizens group, how many of them receive this same information from Canada? And you would be surprised at the number of people that raise their hand and say they've received the same information. Now you wouldn't receive this unless you at least enter once. Unfortunately, about five, six years ago, my husband sent in the money to take a chance on this Canadian Big Five lottery information that was sent to us, and, therefore, every three months we get the same information. Every month, every three months, it is a little different. It also shows pictures of different people that won 46 million, and another one 40 million, another one 55 million, another one 61,980,000, and 23 million, all of them from the United States, but the money is going to Vancouver, Canada, and so I believe it is time that Nebraska now starts a lottery of their own, but I, too, object to the money going into education. I have an amendment up there that will take the proceeds from a state lottery into the General Fund, and let the Legislature decide where the money is going to go and how it is to be spent. But I thought it was important to let you know that this material is being sent all over the City of Omaha, and I am sure throughout the State of Nebraska. And I get it, I will get a new one in about two weeks I am sure of that. Thank you.
