Lynch amendment. Thank you.

PRESIDENT MOUL: Thank you, Senator Smith. Senator Will.

SENATOR WILL: Madam President, I would call the question.

PRESIDENT MOUL: Okay. Senator Will, only Senator Lynch is left to speak. If he would just close. Okay. Senator Lynch.

SENATOR LYNCH: Madam, just...I was going to ask for a point of order. If I explained this incorrectly, one of you great minds on the podium correct me. But as I understand it, in case someone misinterpreted what I said, to vote against the Hall amendment, that is incorrect. What we are voting on is the second half of my original amendment. If you vote...if you vote for the second half, then we retain the second half...the language contained in the second half of the amendment, and that is what I support. When I said oppose the Hall amendment, I wanted to point out that I did not want to take out the second half of the amendment for all the reasons I've already mentioned. So, for those of you that support Carol Pirsch and I and others on the floor about the language contained in my amendment in total, you want to vote for this amendment, which divided the question, and now only considers the second half of my amendment. Is that basically correct? Okay. So, in closing, I would simply say let's do no less, for printers who want to go in this unique business, than we already do for all of those other categories of Nebraskans I already discussed, who have to go through some hoops to be qualified and certified to do business with Nebraskans in Nebraska. I don't think we should treat gambling any differently from any of those other important responsibilities being performed in Nebraska. And so I would simply close by saying vote yes for this division of the question, for the second half of my original amendment, please.

PRESIDENT MOUL: Thank you, Senator Lynch. We'll now vote on the Lynch amendment to the committee amendments. All those in favor please vote aye, opposed nay. Have you all voted? This is the second half of the Lynch amendment to the committee amendment. Have you all voted? Have you all voted?
