addicted to it. And as I understand, they are correcting that, and will be done on Select to address the Hall amendment. With that, I do support this amendment, then, and thank you.

SENATOR WARNER: Senator Will.

SENATOR WILL: Thank you, Mr. President, members of the body. Senator Abboud and Senator Hall and I visited about the amendment. I think that we are agreeing that it might be cleaner to do it on Select File. I am, by the way, 100 percent supportive, and if Senator Abboud would like to address that at this time, I would yield the rest of my time to him.

SENATOR WARNER: Does Senator Abboud yield?

SENATOR ABOUD: Yes, Mr. President. I thought we had a pretty clean amendment here. It was a good amendment up until the other amendment, the earlier Hall amendment, was adopted. I thought that we had it cleaned up enough, but there seems to be generally unanimity of support of this particular amendment to the bill, and for that reason, I would like to withdraw the amendment at this time, bring the amendment back up on Select File, or if we are on the bill. It is currently being cleaned up in bill drafting right now, but I certainly don't want to help to in any way damage the bill, so I would like to withdraw the amendment at this particular time, and return with a cleaned up amendment on Select File, or if I get it down before we move the bill, I'd attach the amendment at that time.

SENATOR WARNER: The amendment is withdrawn. Are there further amendments on the desk?
