

closing, Senator Chambers? Closing is waived. We will vote on the Chambers amendment to the committee amendments. All those in favor please vote aye, opposed nay. Have you all voted on the Chambers amendment? Have you all voted? Please record, Mr. Clerk.

CLERK: 14 ayes, 0 nays, Madam President, on adoption of Senator Chambers' amendment to the committee amendments.

PRESIDENT MOUL: The amendment to the amendments are...is adopted.

CLERK: Madam President, Senator Chambers would move to amend the committee amendments. (Read Chambers amendment, FA145, as found on page 1993 of the Legislative Journal.)

PRESIDENT MOUL: Senator Chambers.

SENATOR CHAMBERS: Madam President and members of the Legislature, for that amendment to be correct, it should strike "one year" and insert "five years". And this would tie into the earlier amendment that is dealing with the judgments against this company which would violate the law. If a judgment is taken against one of these companies for violation of this law, the Secretary of State would lift that license for a period of five years. A one year license suspension is nothing, inconsequential. Breathing space, they could just go some place else, outside of Nebraska and give out more. If there is to be a sanction, it should have enough teeth to at least give pause to the one against whom it will be applied. I've talked to Senator Baack about this. What I had wanted to do, since we're talking about a corporation, and they have high-priced lawyers and they are familiar with the laws in every state, in addition to that, the fact that the only ones who can be in charge of this sampling are the companies and their representatives and agents, they know what their people are doing, my feeling was that, in case of a violation of the law, their license to do this should be revoked permanently. Senator Baack felt that that was too stringent; I don't, but I will take five years instead of one, as currently exists in the bill. So this amendment would insert five years license revocation in place of one, when the manufacturer violates this law. So I ask that you adopt this amendment.
