And it gives...this is the kind of bill that gives Senator Chambers a chance to rant and rave against the lobby, he appreciates that. I'm glad...I'm sure he's glad I brought the bill, because it gives him the opportunity to do that. I think that...I think that the bill has been narrowed down. We've put a lot of things into this bill that tighten up the process, that we can prohibit minors from receiving these samples, and that's what the goal is, is to do that. I do want to provide the company with the ability to sample, but I do not want to have the minors receive those samples. So, with that, I would simply urge the adoption of the committee amendments.
