

deflated property values in the immediate area. We have not received answers to these questions and we think they need to be answered. I have a great deal of difficulty believing that the Department of Environmental Control can issue a license to build this facility in light of the questions that we have asked. Every couple years this body has the opportunity to vote from the heart and I think today you have that opportunity to do that. I would urge your approval of LB 72. Thank you.

PRESIDENT MOUL: Thank you, Senator Dierks. We will now vote on the motion to advance LB 72. All those in favor please vote aye, opposed nay. Senator Dierks.

SENATOR DIERKS: I would like to ask for a call of the house, please, and a roll call vote.

PRESIDENT MOUL: I have a request for a call of the house and a roll call vote. All those in favor please vote aye, opposed nay. Have you all voted? Please record, Mr. Clerk.

CLERK: 19 ayes, 0 nays to go under call, Madam President.

PRESIDENT MOUL: The house is under call. Would all unexcused senators please return to the Chambers and record their presence. All unauthorized personnel must leave the floor. Would the senators please be seated and please check in. Senator Hillman and Senator Robak, would you please check in. Senator Hillman, would you please check in. Would the senators...Senator Chambers, please check in. We are still looking for Senator Chambers. If the senators would please be seated, we will proceed with a roll call vote on the motion to advance LB 72. Please proceed, Mr. Clerk.

CLERK: (Roll call vote taken. See pages 2014-15 of the Legislative Journal.) 26 ayes, 17 nays.

PRESIDENT MOUL: LB 72 is advanced. Proceed with LB 167 and I will raise the call. Mr. Clerk, would you...do you have items for the record?
