LB 843, 845

and since you asked the questions on the record, I'm giving what answers I have on the record.

SENATOR WARNER PRESIDING

SENATOR WARNER: Seeing no further lights, Senator Moore, do you wish to close on the motion to adopt the committee amendments to the bill?

SENATOR MOORE: I just move that the committee amendments be adopted.

SENATOR WARNER: The motion pending is the adoption of the committee amendments. Those in favor vote aye, opposed nay. It requires 25 votes. Have you all voted? Clerk, record.

CLERK: 25 ayes, 0 nays.

SENATOR WARNER: The motion is carried. The amendments are adopted. Senator Moore, what do you wish to do with the bill?

SENATOR MOORE: I move the bill be advanced.

SENATOR WARNER: The motion is to advance LB 843. Is there any discussion? Seeing none, those in favor vote aye, opposed nay. Have you all voted? Clerk, record.

CLERK: 26 ayes, 0 nays on the motion to advance, Mr. President.

SENATOR WARNER: The motion carried. The bill is advanced. LB 845, Mr. Clerk.

CLERK: Mr. President, 845 was a bill originally introduced by the Speaker at the request of the Governor. (Read title.) The bill was introduced on January 31, referred to Appropriations, advanced to General File. I have committee amendments pending by the Appropriations Committee.

SPEAKER BAACK: Senator Moore.

SENATOR MOORE: Well, Mr. Speaker and members, actually the committee amendments are actually, I believe, the same dollar amount that the Governor had in the bill. We changed slightly
