CLERK: LB 846A, Mr. President, introduced by the Speaker at the request of the Governor. (Read title.) The bill was introduced on January 31, referred to Appropriations, advanced to General File. I do have Appropriations Committee amendments pending.

SPEAKER BAACK: Senator Moore, for the Appropriations Committee amendments.

SENATOR MOORE: This is simply the dollar amounts that match the recommendation I already explained. So I would move for advancement of LB 84...first off, I would move for the adoption of the committee amendments to LB 846A.

SPEAKER BAACK: Any discussion on the adoption of the committee amendments? Seeing none, we will now vote on the committee amendments for LB 846A. All in favor vote aye, opposed vote no. We're voting on the committee amendments of LB 846A. Have you all voted? Record, Mr. Clerk.
