SENATOR MOORE: Yes, these are the...well, the Appropriations Committee amendments differ slightly. There were some final numbers that came in after the Governor had finally hired the Tax Commissioner and there were some slight differences. But, basically, I will just explain the bill right now. LB 842 is the salary bill for the constitutional officers and the Tax Commissioner. By...all of these items are tracked in a different sub-program within agencies and this is by constitutional requirement a separate bill. And so this is the salary bill for the State Auditor, Secretary of State, State Treasurer, Governor, Lieutenant Governor, and the Tax Commissioner, as well as Secretary of State. And so, with that, I move for the adoption of the committee amendments.

SPEAKER BAACK: Any discussion on the committee amendments to LB 842? Seeing none, we will vote on the committee amendments to LB 842. All those in favor vote aye, opposed vote no. Record, Mr. Clerk.

CLERK: 25 ayes, 0 nays on adoption of the committee amendments, Mr. President.

SPEAKER BAACK: The committee amendments are adopted. On the bill, Senator Moore.

SENATOR MOORE: I explained the bill. This is the constitutional officers' salary. I would move for its advancement.

SPEAKER BAACK: Any discussion on the advancement of LB 842? Seeing none, we will vote on the advancement of LB 842. All those in favor vote aye, opposed vote no. Voting on the advancement of LB 842. Have you all voted? We're voting on the advancement of LB 842. Have you all voted? Record, Mr. Clerk.

CLERK: 26 ayes, 0 nays, Mr. President, on the advancement of 842.
