SENATOR MOORE: No, I would argue that the Wayne building was one that the committee, even in the early stages, felt...to begin with it was the number one priority from the state colleges, the committee was convinced of the need at Wayne, and that was something, in the early stages, was something that the committee wanted to do. Now if any of the committee members disagree with that statement, I would urge you to ask that question of them.

SENATOR KRISTENSEN: Okay.

SENATOR MOORE: But the other thing, while we're traveling down this line, I mean...well, I'll let you keep asking the questions before I start.

SENATOR KRISTENSEN: No, there's a couple questions I know better than to ask.

SENATOR MOORE: Well I was hoping you'd ask me the one that I want to answer, but you probably won't.

SENATOR KRISTENSEN: (Laughter.) That's right. The other questions I have is in regard to the Beadle Center. And by putting money in at this amount what do you think, as a practical matter, not as a legal matter, but as a practical matter, we, as a body, are locking ourselves into for future construction with the Beadle Center, and what other things are going to be the logical conclusion so in about two years when they come in and say, well we've got this center, but to really make it work we've got to have this, this and this, what other sorts of things are out there with Beadle, from your point of view, are we locking ourselves into as a practical nature, maybe not as a legal matter?
