

it's to serve as a clean bill to amend things to the original intent of what is possibly and for whatever reason the committee did not choose to use the Governor's bill as the vehicle for the mainline bill. This bill could have been used and obviously in this case as it has now become what has been known as the trailer bill, this is a clean bill that simply, the committee amendments now become the bill. The committee amendments, you can either refer to page 34 of your budget book and I have also distributed for you your review of the definition of AM1507. There are 28 different items contained in this bill that include a variety of state agencies and a variety of aspects. Instead of going through and explaining them bit by bit, I will just only ask that you look at those. I'm sure you've read about those in the press. This trailer bill is, though it's separate from our mainline bill, it is certainly in the committee's totals and is part of our total budget recommendation. And so at this time I'd entertain any questions about any or all of the items in this committee amendment.

PRESIDENT MOUL: Thank you, Senator Moore. Mr. Clerk, are there amendments on the desk?

CLERK: Madam President, Senator Robak would move to amend the committee amendments.

PRESIDENT MOUL: Senator Robak.

SENATOR ROBAK: Thank you, Madam President and members of the body, this amendment is AM1622. It's on page 2,003 of the Journal, I had printed in the Journal. This would appropriate \$200,000 of General Fund money for the fiscal year 1991-1992, and an additional 200,000 of General Fund money for the fiscal year 1992 and 1993 for use automating our 14 public resource libraries throughout the state. But bear in mind this is only a one-time appropriation. I would just like to give you a little background on this amendment and then I'll talk about what it means to automate a library and the benefits of adopting this amendment would be. This amendment was originally brought to the Appropriations Committee in the form of a request for \$800,000 of next year's budget. There were some fears that this would take money from the Film and Audio Visions Program. However, my amendment does not take any money from the Film and Audio Visual. This amendment is designed to try and fund a very worthwhile project that would certainly provide many benefits to the community and states for years to come. The amendment
