CLERK: (Read LB 255 on Final Reading.)

PRESIDENT MOUL: All provisions of law relative to procedure having been complied with, the question is, shall LB 255 pass with the emergency clause attached? All those in favor please vote aye, opposed nay. Have you all voted? Senator Warner.

PRESIDENT MOUL: Please clear the board, Mr. Clerk. Record the vote, and then we will have the senators check in. Would everyone please check in and record your presence. We are looking for Senator Nelson and Senator Schrock. Senator Wesely, would you please check in. Senator Landis and Lynch, would you please check in. Senators Robinson, Cudaback, and Schimek, please check in. Senator Warner.

SENATOR WARNER: I was just going to indicate that a call in vote would be appropriate.

PRESIDENT MOUL: Sergeant At Arms, we are looking for Senators Nelson and Schrock.

CLERK: Senator Schrock voting yes. Senator Haberman voting yes. Senator Beutler voting yes.

PRESIDENT MOUL: Please record, Mr. Clerk.

CLERK: (Read record vote. See pages 2050-51 of the Legislative Journal.) 35 ayes, 0 nays, 1 present and not voting, 13 excused and not voting, Madam President.
