SENATOR MOORE: Simple majority, okay.

PRESIDENT MOUL: Have you all voted? Senator Lamb.

SENATOR LAMB: We may as well get to it and have a call of the house and a roll call, please.

PRESIDENT MOUL: A call of the house has been requested. All those in favor please vote aye, opposed nay. Have you all voted? Please record, Mr. Clerk.

CLERK: 18 ayes, 0 nays to go under call, Madam President.

Senators, please be seated and please check in.
