SPEAKER BAACK: LB 748 advances. Do you have any items for the record, Mr. Clerk? We will move now to LB 836.

CLERK: Mr. President, LB 836, the first order of business are enrollment and review amendments.

SPEAKER BAACK: Senator Lindsay.

SENATOR LINDSAY: Mr. Speaker, I move the adoption of the E & R amendments to LB 836.

SPEAKER BAACK: You've heard the motion to adopt the E & R amendments to LB 836. All those in favor say aye. Opposed no. They are adopted.

CLERK: Mr. President, Senator Wesely would move to amend the bill. Senator, your amendment is found on page 1981 of the Journal.

SPEAKER BAACK: Senator Wesely.

SENATOR WESELY: Mr. Speaker, members, this corrects an error in a piece of legislation passed by Senator Landis a couple of years ago dealing with school districts and their role in child care services. It was an inadvertent error dealing with which school districts were covered by that and the bill drafter caught the error and this corrects it. So it's a technical amendment to do that. Move for the adoption of the amendment.

SPEAKER BAACK: Discussion on the amendment by Senator Wesely. Seeing none, we will vote on the amendment by Senator Wesely. All those in favor vote aye, opposed vote no. We are voting on the amendment by Senator Wesely. Have you all voted? Have you all voted? We are voting on the amendment by Senator Wesely. Have you all voted? Record, Mr. Clerk.

CLERK: 25 ayes, 0 nays, Mr. President, on adoption of Senator Wesely's amendment.

SPEAKER BAACK: The amendment is adopted.
