SENATOR WESELY: It's my amendment, that's the reason Senator Moore doesn't know about it.

CLERK: Senator, I apologize, it is...excuse me.

SPEAKER BAACK: Now who doesn't know what they're doing. Senator Wesely. (Wesely amendment appears on pages 2069-70 of the Legislative Journal.)

SENATOR WESELY: All right. This amendment deals with the various amendments we just adopted. It makes the changes, they're all Cash Fund related and will be the last amendment on the bill. I'm sure Senator Warner will be happy about that. So I move the adoption of this last amendment.

SPEAKER BAACK: Any discussion of the amendment by Senator Wesely? Seeing none, you've heard the motion to adopt the amendment. We'll now vote on that amendment. All those in favor vote aye, opposed vote no. Have you all voted? Record, Mr. Clerk.

CLERK: 26 ayes, 0 nays, Mr. President, on adoption of Senator Wesely's amendment.

SPEAKER BAACK: The amendment is adopted.

CLERK: I have nothing further on the bill, Senator.

SPEAKER BAACK: Senator Will.

SENATOR WILL: Mr. Speaker, I move the advancement of LB 703A to E & R for engrossment.

SPEAKER BAACK: You've heard the motion to advance LB 703A. All those in favor say aye. Opposed no. It is advanced. Mr. Clerk, items for the record.

CLERK: Mr. President, I have a notice of hearing from the Revenue Committee, confirmation hearing. That's signed by Senator Hall as Chair of the committee. Senator Wehrbein has amendments to LB 714; Senator Hefner to LB 320; Senator Hall to LB 320; Senator Withem to LB 843; Senator Withem to LB 719; and Senator Abboud to LB 847; Senator Lindsay to LB 181; and Senator Landis to LB 760.
