

but when the specifics, and that's where the differences are made on these little nitty-gritty issues like this one do we save a little bit of money on the way we operate our judicial system or do we just put more money into it. When the specifics come up it is difficult to have the belly to get it done. So this add, I'd urge you to adopt this amendment so we can get onto discussing some of the other legislation we have before us this afternoon. Originally Senator Bernard-Stevens and I had drafted an amendment this morning that would have been a simple sunset. As I indicated, Senator Lindsay's eagle eye of reading the Constitution came into play and that may not have worked. This is the best thing we can do in terms of a sunset. Senator Bernard-Stevens, did you want to take any time? Okay, he and I had originally co-sponsored the original amendment. I thought he might have an interest in speaking. He doesn't, so if you would like to go ahead and call the vote, Madam Chair, I'd appreciate it.

PRESIDENT MOUL: Thank you, Senator Withem. We will now vote on the Withem amendment. All those in favor please vote aye, opposed nay. Have you all voted? Please record, Mr. Clerk.

CLERK: 27 ayes, 2 nays, Madam President, on adoption of Senator Withem's amendment.

PRESIDENT MOUL: The amendment is adopted. Before we continue with debate on the bill itself, I would like to direct the senators' attention to the south balcony. Special guest today of Senator Warner are 60 fourth graders and their teachers from Norris Elementary School in Firth, Nebraska. Would you rise and be recognized by the Legislature. Welcome to the Chamber. Also seated in the south balcony are 16 students from R-6 School District, a junior high school in Holdrege, Nebraska and their teachers. Would you please rise and be welcomed. They are guests of Senator Schrock. Thank you. We'll proceed with debate on the bill itself, Senator Moore.

SENATOR MOORE: Yes, Madam President, if Senator Chizek would yield to a question.
