There will be judicial bypass, however the expense of it has been taken out, the confidentiality has been reassured, and the process has been made about as easy as a procedure can be made in our judicial system for a litigant. So I appreciate the fact that Senator Lindsay and others who are strong supporters of notification have been willing to take the time to do the smoothing over, which will be important to a lot of people out there, eventually. Thank you.

PRESIDENT MOUL: Thank you, Senator Beutler. Senator Labedz, followed by Senator Lindsay. Senator Labedz.

SENATOR LABEDZ: Thank you, Madam President. I rise to also support the Rasmussen-Lindsay amendment. And it did take a lot of work and meetings, and a lot of changes made from the original amendment. So I appreciate the fact both sides have got some good things in the amendment. So I appreciate the hard work that has been done on this amendment and will totally support it. Thank you.

PRESIDENT MOUL: Thank you, Senator Labedz. Mr. Clerk, do you have an announcement?

CLERK: Briefly, Madam President. Senator Nelson would like to have an Exec Session of the Retirement Systems Committee, underneath the south balcony very soon. Retirement Systems Committee, under the south balcony.

PRESIDENT MOUL: Thank you, Mr. Clerk. Senator Lindsay.

SENATOR LINDSAY: Thank you, Madam President. Members of the body, I don't know if Senator Nelson was anticipating me talking when she announced she wanted people to leave, maybe. Anyway I rise in support of the amendment. We put a lot of work into this. We had input from my office, from Senator Rasmussen's office, I believe from Senator Beutler's office, from people at Planned Parenthood, from people at Right to Life, we had a lot of people put together, trying to get an amendment that would streamline the system. And I understand that opponents of the bill, this was going to bring them on board. But it hopefully will make them a little more comfortable with the way the system works. It think it has streamlined the process, clarified the
