Legislative Journal.) The vote is 42 ayes, 0 nays, 1 present and not voting, 6 excused and not voting.

SPEAKER BAACK: LB 850 with the emergency clause attached passes. We will now go to LB 852E.

ASSISTANT CLERK: (Read LB 852E on Final Reading.)

SPEAKER BAACK: All provisions of law relative to procedure having been complied with, the question is, shall LB 852 with the emergency clause attached pass? All those in favor vote aye, opposed vote no. Have you all voted? Record, Mr. Clerk.

ASSISTANT CLERK: (Record vote read. See pages 2168-69 of the Legislative Journal.) The vote is 41 ayes, 0 nays, 1 present and not voting, 7 excused and not voting.

SPEAKER BAACK: LB 852 with the emergency clause attached passes. We will now proceed to Item 6 on the agenda, to General File.

CLERK: Mr. President, LB 854A was a bill introduced by Senator Moore. (Read title.)

SPEAKER BAACK: Senator Moore.

SENATOR MOORE: Yes, Mr. Speaker, and members, both of these bills are the A bills that go along with the commercial driver's license bill and the teacher certificate fee bill as well. LB 854A is the bill dealing with the Department of Motor Vehicles and the commercial driver's license. It actually appropriates money from the General Fund to the tune of \$126,000. That is because that driver's license fee does not directly go into the Cash Fund. It actually goes into the General Fund and so the increase in the bill is then appropriated through this bill. And so I ask for the advancement of 854A.

SPEAKER BAACK: Any discussion on LB 854A? Seeing none, Senator Moore, do you wish to close? Waives closing. We will now vote on the advancement of LB 854A. All those in favor vote aye, opposed vote no. Record, Mr. Clerk.

CLERK: 28 ayes, 0 nays, Mr. President, on the advancement of 854A.
