SPEAKER BAACK: Senator Schmit.

SENATOR SCHMIT: Let's have a roll call vote, Mr. President.

SPEAKER BAACK: Roll call vote has been requested. Okay. Members, please take your seats. We are...the house is under call, and we're going to do a roll call vote. Please hold your conversations down so the Clerk can hear the roll. Mr. Clerk, call the roll.

CLERK: (Roll call vote taken. See pages 2172-73 the Legislative Journal.) 25 ayes, 12 nays, Mr. President.

SPEAKER BAACK: The amendment is adopted. Anything further on the bill, Mr. Clerk?

CLERK: I have nothing further on the bill, Mr. President.

SPEAKER BAACK: We will now move to...I will raise the call. We will move to the advancement of LB 470. Senator Landis.

SENATOR LANDIS: Thank you, Mr. Speaker. The last amendment cut out one-half of the bill and left the other half. Let me tell you the players involved, because people just don't tell us these stories, or they haven't in the past, and you ought to know what's going on. FirstTier, in Omaha, wants to expand its holdings. It's growing well, got a good, solid deposit base, they also look at Sarpy County, they'd like to move into Sarpy County. We originally had a bill that said unlimited branching. Then we used the 25 mile limit, and basically that allowed them to get outside of Omaha and into Sarpy County. That issue got linked, before the session, with what Norwest wants. And
