SPEAKER BAACK: (Mike not activated immediately.) ...George W. Norris Legislative Chamber. Roll call.

CLERK: Have a quorum present, Mr. President.

SPEAKER BAACK: Do you have any items for the record, Mr. Clerk?

CLERK: I do, Mr. President. Enrollment and Review reports LB 170 and LB 748 to Select File and both have E & R amendments attached. (See pages 2175-76 of the Legislative Journal.)

And Senator Beutler would like to print amendments to LB 256, Mr. President. (See page 2176 of the Legislative Journal.) That's all that I have.

SPEAKER BAACK: We will now proceed to Item 7, General File and LB 511.

CLERK: Mr. President, LB 511 was a bill originally introduced by Senators Lamb, Dierks, Hefner, Wickersham, Cudaback, Warner, Elmer. (Read title.) The bill was introduced on January 22 of this year, referred to the Government Committee. The bill was reported to General File, I'm sorry, the bill was placed on General File notwithstanding the committee action. That motion was offered by Senator Lamb. The bill was discussed on April 4 and again on April 5, Mr. President. At that time Senator Lamb had amendments that were adopted. There was an amendment to the bill by Senator Morrissey that was adopted. I do have amendments pending, Mr. President.
