Natural Resources Commission. I don't like that. I don't like that. I don't think it is the way it should be done. As I mentioned before, when I was talking about Senator Beutler's comments, that we are going to have different zoning regulation in each county with these streams under my original bill, and that might be true, but I don't know that that is bad. Why not let the people have, local people have the right to have some direct local input into the situation. I ain't going to oppose the bill. I am going to ask that the bill be advanced. I will have to think about what we are doing here on Select File to decide whether...what I should do. So I'd ask at this point that the bill be advanced.

SPEAKER BAACK: You have heard Senator Lamb's closing on the advancement of LB 511. We will now vote on the advancement of LB 511. All those in favor vote aye, opposed vote no. We are voting on the advancement of LB 511. Have you all voted? Have you all voted? Senator Lamb.

SENATOR LAMB: Mr. Speaker, looks as if we are a couple of votes short, so unless somebody does something right away, I would have to ask for a call of the...
