

SENATOR MOORE: Okay. Well, that's enough technical questions.

SENATOR CONWAY: One minute.

SENATOR MOORE: Since I only have a minute left, I better get on to the statement. You know there are a lot of things in this...even in this bill that I may or may not like. I think, as we've already stated for a variety of reasons on the federal level, but more importantly my concern is that the gun buyer in this state be protected from onerous regulations, like the original LB 355. I think the bill, as it would now stand under this amendment, is so far removed from LB 355, everybody needs to understand that. You're talking about a buyer permit card, and as far as I'm concerned, if I was, and I am not, a gun buyer, I would prefer to go the buyer permit route on beyond '95, because then that's a one-time fee I pay every three years. Senator Ashford, I'd still prefer to make it every four years, at least for now I can agree with three years, four years like a drivers license. But I think in many ways actually that portion of the bill, when it's all said and done, may actually be better for the law abiding, gun buying citizens of the State of Nebraska than the instant check. And I guess I will vote for this bill today. The one thing I've always wanted to do was to create something...

SENATOR CONWAY: Time.

SENATOR MOORE: ...that would allow us to better patrol felons and other people getting guns. The last thing I want to point out is that those in handgun ink and others, is does this bill accomplish great things in...

SENATOR CONWAY: Time.

SENATOR MOORE: ...in preventing murders in this state, probably not. But it does...it is a little step forward, and I'll vote for that.
