

SENATOR WARNER: ...but I am trying to create an understanding that we don't have an issue...an argument...

SENATOR ASHFORD: Right, right.

SENATOR WARNER: ...at some point, four or five years from now,...

SENATOR ASHFORD: Right.

SENATOR WARNER: ...as to what those were,...

SPEAKER BAACK: Time.

SENATOR ASHFORD: Right.

SENATOR WARNER: ...or intended. Thank you.

SPEAKER BAACK: Thank you, Senator Warner. Senator Chizek, did you wish to discuss the advancement of the bill? Senator Hefner, the advancement of 355.

SENATOR HEFNER: Mr. President and members of the body, I still don't know if I'll vote to advance this bill. I did support the amendment. I feel that it makes LB 355 better than it was. But I've kind of been against gun control all along, and so I don't know at this time. I do have a couple questions that I'd like to ask of Senator Brad Ashford.

SENATOR ASHFORD: Yes.

SENATOR HEFNER: Senator Ashford, who furnishes these certificates to the local law enforcement people?

SENATOR ASHFORD: The certificates are furnished by the state, and there is a fiscal note on the bill, Senator Hefner, that indicates that the cost is around \$4,000. They're intended to be uniform certificates that are circulated to the local law enforcement offices.

SENATOR HEFNER: Okay. And these would be sent to the local police chief, or the county sheriff in that particular county?

SENATOR ASHFORD: Yes, sir.
