

SENATOR CONWAY: Thank you, Senator Hefner. The next speaker will be Senator Crosby, if you would like to speak to the advancement.

SENATOR CROSBY: Thank you, Mr. President, and members, I just want to reiterate my feelings that I expressed earlier and I did vote for the amendment which becomes the bill. Brad, I think we should call this LB 801355 maybe, just because, as Senator Schellpeper said earlier, that the number 355 has become a trigger to those who do not like gun control and when they hear that number then they think that we've passed the wrong bill. But, at any rate, I will support the passage. And a lot of my questions...I did have a bunch of questions but a lot of them have been answered as we go along this morning. So I don't really have a lot of other questions to ask nor any other comments, except that I think probably I will try once more, Brad, during the summer or the fall to get some of those people who were with us a week ago together just...just get them together with myself and discuss again all the feelings they have. And then I will go back to all the people who called from the beginning, two years ago, or who wrote on either side of the bill, and try to visit with a lot of them so everybody understands what we did today because I think that's very important. And I hope that when the NRA letter goes out that they will be fair about it and try to get their members to understand that we're just trying to get a good bill that will be good for the whole state and for those responsible gun owners and that the people who are for gun...handgun control will try to understand that we did the best we could today with 801355 or 355801, whatever you want to call it. Thank you.
