

for the adoption of the amendment.

SENATOR CONWAY: Thank you, Senator Nelson. The motion is to adopt the Nelson amendment. All in favor of adopting the Nelson amendment vote aye, opposed nay. Mr. Clerk.

CLERK: 25 ayes, 0 nays, Mr. President, on adoption of Senator Nelson's amendment.

SENATOR CONWAY: Senator Nelson's amendment is adopted. We are now back to the bill, LB 549. Senator Nelson, would you like to speak to the bill?

SENATOR NELSON: I partially mentioned what the bill contained a few minutes ago. It is the clean-up bill of the Retirement Committee. I don't know as I want to say necessarily a "trust me" bill but I did point out to you some of the main provisions and I just move that we advance it to E & R.

SENATOR CONWAY: Thank you, Senator Nelson. Before moving to the next speaker, I would like to recognize guests of Senator Abboud in the south balcony. We have seven third and fourth graders from Covenant Christian in Omaha and their teacher. Would they please stand and be recognized. Thank you for coming to the Legislature. Senator Moore, your light is on relative to the retirement bill. He waives off. There are no other lights. Senator Nelson.

SENATOR NELSON: I just move to advance the bill.

SENATOR CONWAY: Thank you, Senator. The motion is to advance LB 549. All in favor signify by voting aye, opposed nay. Excuse me, say aye. Opposed nay. The bill is advanced. Moving now to LB 456.

CLERK: I have E & R amendments, first of all, to 456, Mr. President.

SENATOR CONWAY: Senator Will.

SENATOR WILL: Mr. President, I move the adoption of the E & R amendments to LB 456.

SENATOR CONWAY: The motion is to adopt the E & R amendments. Signify by saying aye for approval. Opposed. They are adopted.
