SPEAKER BAACK: Any discussion on the amendment offered by Senator Wesely? Seeing none, do you wish to close, Senator Wesely? Waives closing. We will now vote on the amendment. All those in favor vote aye, opposed vote no. Record, Mr. Clerk.

CLERK: 27 ayes, 0 nays on adoption of Senator Wesely's amendment, Mr. President.

SPEAKER BAACK: The amendment is adopted. Anything further on the bill?

CLERK: Nothing further on the bill.

SPEAKER BAACK: Senator Will.

SENATOR WILL: Mr. Speaker, I move the advancement of LB 456A to E & R for Engrossment.

SPEAKER BAACK: You've heard the motion to advance LB 456A. All those in favor say aye. Opposed no. It is advanced. We will pass over LB 503 and LB 503A and go to LB 795.

CLERK: LB 795, Mr. President, Enrollment and Review amendments have been adopted. I have pending, first of all, an amendment to the bill by Senator Hall. Senator, I have your AM1468 in front of me.

SPEAKER BAACK: Senator Hall.

SENATOR HALL: Mr. Speaker, I would like to ask that that be substituted with AM1650, if I could, please. It's a redraft of the same provision.

SPEAKER BAACK: Any objection? No objection, so ordered.
