

race track. It's just a matter of areas and as I said the district that I represent, Omaha and Ralston, I can see there's a relationship between a city having both of them, but I don't see the relationship between county and city.

SENATOR WEHRBEIN: Thank you.

SENATOR WARNER: Senator Abboud, your light was on next. Is there further discussion? If not, Senator Abboud, do you wish to close on your amendment to the amendment?

SENATOR ABOUD: Mr. President, colleagues, it's a simple amendment. I think it's a matter of fairness. I can understand the limitation on gambling dollars, but I think if they're going to make an extension it should possibly be a statewide fund rather than limiting it by county and if they choose to limit it by county, it should just be within the municipality having both of those activities going on. So I urge the adoption of the amendment.

SENATOR WARNER: Motion is the adoption of Senator Abboud's amendment to the amendment. Those in favor vote aye, opposed nay. It requires 25 votes. Have you all voted? Have you all voted that are going to vote? Senator Abboud. Clerk, record.

CLERK: 3 ayes, 12 nays, Mr. President, on adoption of Senator Abboud's amendment.

SENATOR WARNER: Amendment fails. Are there further amendments on the desk?

CLERK: Nothing further pending to Senator Johnson's amendment, Mr. President.

SENATOR WARNER: Now we'll go to the adoption of Senator Johnson's amendment. Senator Labeledz, do you wish to address the amendment? Motion pending is the adoption of the Johnson amendment. Senator Labeledz.

SENATOR LABEDZ: Thank you, Mr. President. I rise in support of the amendment of Senator Rod Johnson. I was hoping that Senator Schmit would leave because I know that he will object to what I'm saying, that I'm not a race horse enthusiast. I did go to, I think, 10 races in my whole life and probably all 10 of them Senator Schmit was there also and I may, if Senator Chambers was
