

the PSL in the Foster Care Review Board. So, with that, I would ask for the adoption of this amendment and then we can talk about the whole series of amendments which would then be 14 items which are listed in the handout.

SPEAKER BAACK: Discussion on the amendment to the amendment by Senator Moore. Seeing none, Senator Moore, do you wish to close?

SENATOR MOORE: I move adoption of the amendment to the amendment.

SPEAKER BAACK: We will now vote on the amendment to the amendment offered by Senator Moore. All those in favor vote aye, opposed vote no. Have you all voted? This does require 25 votes? Record, Mr. Clerk.

CLERK: 26 ayes, 0 nays, Madam President...Mr. President, on adoption of Senator Moore's amendment to the Moore amendment.

SPEAKER BAACK: That's okay, Patrick. The amendment is adopted. Now we're on the amendment as amended by Senator Moore. Senator Moore.

SENATOR MOORE: If I may explain the amendment now, this is all now we've amended amendment 1937 into 1895. It's printed on page 2228 of the Journal. The three additions, we just explained. If you care to look at your handout, I will explain very briefly what is in this bill. It's a series of technical amendments that the Appropriations Committee has voted on that would amend the mainline bill and I will talk about them briefly. Number one is the Supreme Court to simply correct the calculation error and eliminate an unnecessary reference to a separate program. Secondly, the Governor reappropriated a balance as we already mentioned. Number three is the State Department of Education where we simply had, through all the haste, had left out a program in the bill and so it's strictly federal funds. It's \$3.3 million but technically makes the bill read correct in putting that...those federal funds in the Department of Education's budget. Fourth, Health Department earmark amount, specifically earmark the amount provided for the Cancer Registry, earmarks that in statute. And so with some corresponding percentage increase we've given in another bill, it makes it clear what the intent was. Fifth, there was some carry-over money there that increased the cash in the Cancer
