And I think Senator Coordsen's amendment this morning was kind of a come-home-and-kick-the-dog amendment because it wasn't the dog's fault that all this happened though in some ways it kind of was, I guess. But it was a little more punitive than probably was proper and Senator Coordsen has an amendment that would have decreased that funding considerably, would have kicked the dog hard for something that the dog wasn't totally in control of, or maybe the dog just didn't know better yet, where I think Senator Coordsen has now put a more substantial leash on the dog of the right...of the proper weight to keep the dog in line, I think this would be a better way to deal with Senator Coordsen's problem and I certainly rise to support it.

SPEAKER BAACK: Thank you, Senator Moore. Any other discussion? Senator Wesely.

SENATOR WESELY: Yeah. Mr. Speaker, members, I think Senator Moore said it very well but I think Senator Coordsen is right on target. We do need accountability when we put expenditures out, we do expect them to be spent in the manner intended by the Legislature and I think this makes sense. I would support the Coordsen amendment.

SPEAKER BAACK: Thank you, Senator Wesely. Any other discussion? Senator Coordsen, would you like to close?

SENATOR COORDSEN: I would resist the temptations to...it reminds me of several stories but will resist them at this time, Senator Moore. Just move the adoption of the amendment.

SPEAKER BAACK: We will now vote on the amendment by Senator Coordsen. All those in favor vote aye, opposed vote no. We are voting on the amendment by Senator Coordsen. Have you all voted? Have you all voted? We are voting on the amendment by Senator Coordsen. Have you all voted? Record, Mr. Clerk.

CLERK: 26 ayes, 0 nays, Mr. President, on adoption of Senator Coordsen's amendment.

SPEAKER BAACK: The amendment is adopted. Mr. Clerk.
