PRESIDENT MOUL: The amendment is adopted. Is there anything further on the bill, Mr. Clerk?

CLERK: Nothing further on the bill, Madam President.

PRESIDENT MOUL: Does anyone else wish to speak on the bill, itself? Seeing none, Senator Will.

SENATOR WILL: Madam President, I move the advancement of LB 843 to E & R for grossment.

PRESIDENT MOUL: You have heard the motion to advance LB 843. All those in favor please say aye. Opposed nay. LB 843 is advanced. Speaker Baack. Mr. Clerk, do you have any items for the record?

CLERK: Well, Madam President, I do have one motion with respect to a hearing scheduled for this Thursday by Senator Hall. Senator Hall would move to suspend the notice of hearing rule so as to permit the public hearing on LR 186CA.

PRESIDENT MOUL: Senator Hall.

SENATOR HALL: Thank you, Madam President. I would just move the adoption of the rule suspension in order to hold the public hearing Thursday...on Thursday, at 8:00 a.m., on the Governor's constitutional amendment. Would urge adoption.

PRESIDENT MOUL: Thank you, Senator Hall. All those in favor of the motion please vote aye, opposed nay. This is a motion to suspend rules. Have you all voted on the motion to suspend the rules? Please record, Mr. Clerk.

CLERK: 31 ayes, 1 nay, Madam President, on the motion to suspend the rules.
