

Amendments are adopted.

CLERK: Madam President, Senator Moore would move to amend the bill. Senator, I have your AM1585 in front of me. (Moore amendment appears on page 2228 of the Legislative Journal.)

PRESIDENT MOUL: Senator Moore.

SENATOR MOORE: Yes, AM1585, what that is is corrects an error that was made in the drafting of the bill. It does not impact how it shows on the financial status, it simply says 309 funding, whereas initially we had mistakenly placing the \$2 million coming, 1 million out of the State Building Fund, and 1 million out of Nebraska Capital Construction Fund. It was indeed the committee's intent to all come out of NCCF. This amendment actually legitimizes what our intent was and makes the whole entire 2 million for 309 come out of NCCF. And so, with that, I ask for adoption of the amendment.

PRESIDENT MOUL: Thank you, Senator Moore. Is there anyone who wishes to speak to this amendment? Seeing none, we will vote on the Moore amendment. All those in favor please vote aye, opposed nay. Have you all voted on the Moore amendment? Please record, Mr. Clerk.

CLERK: 25 ayes, 0 nays, Madam President, on adoption of Senator Moore's amendment.

PRESIDENT MOUL: The amendment is adopted.

CLERK: Madam President, Senator Abboud would move to amend. Senator, I have your AM1587 in front of me, that was printed on page 2075 of the Journal.

PRESIDENT MOUL: Senator Abboud.

SENATOR ABOUD: Yes, thank you, Madam President. Members of the Legislature, this amendment is relatively straightforward. It comes from the 309 Task Force Committee. The committee voted to support providing for an additional \$500,000 to go towards roof construction. In particular, the money will be used for three separate areas. Now the 309 Task Force has the responsibility to replace certain state building parts. The three areas, first is the roofs of a number of state buildings throughout the state; second, involves energy conservation; and
