LB 842, 847

PRESIDENT MOUL: The motion fails. Is there anything further on the bill, Mr. Clerk? I will raise the call.

CLERK: Senator Abboud, you want the other amendment withdrawn, Senator? Okay. Madam President, I have nothing further to this bill.

PRESIDENT MOUL: Senator Will.

SENATOR WILL: Madam President, I move the advancement of LB 847 to E & R for engrossment.

PRESIDENT MOUL: You heard the motion to advance LB 847. All those in favor please say aye. Opposed nay. LB 847 is advanced. LB 842.

CLERK: Madam President, 842, first item I have is an amendment to the bill by Senator Moore. (See AM1894 on page 2227 of the Legislative Journal.)

PRESIDENT MOUL: Senator Moore.

SENATOR MOORE: This corrects another mistake the Fiscal Office made. Actually, what we did, we had double-counted in the Attorney General's Office health insurance twice in a program. This backs it down and only counts it once proper, and once again this has no impact on financial status. We just didn't correct the gaps in the bill. So, with that, it would count the Attorney General's program once instead of twice to try and make it correct, so I ask for the adoption of the amendment.

PRESIDENT MOUL: Thank you, Senator Moore. Does anyone wish to debate this? Seeing none, all those in favor please vote aye, opposed nay. Have you all voted? Please record, Mr. Clerk.

CLERK: 28 ayes, 0 nays, Madam President, on adoption of Senator Moore's amendment.

PRESIDENT MOUL: The amendment is adopted.

CLERK: I have nothing further on the bill, Madam President.

PRESIDENT MOUL: Senator Will.

SENATOR WILL: Madam President, I move the advancement of LB 842
