PRESIDENT MOUL: Senator Will.

SENATOR WILL: Madam President, I move for the adoption of the E & R amendments to LB 647A.

PRESIDENT MOUL: You've heard the motion to adopt the amendments. All those in favor please say aye. Opposed nay. The E & R amendments are adopted.

CLERK: Senator Warner, you had amendments. Senator Warner, do you want to withdraw your amendment to the A bill, Senator? Madam President, I have nothing further to the A bill.

SENATOR WILL: Madam President, I move for the advancement of LB 647A to E & R for engrossment.

PRESIDENT MOUL: You've heard the motion to advance LB 647A. All those in favor please vote...say aye. Opposed nay. LB 647A is advanced. LB 760.

CLERK: LB 760, Madam President, the...I have no E & R amendments. The first amendment I have to the bill is by Senator Landis.

PRESIDENT MOUL: Senator Landis.

SENATOR LANDIS: Oh, no you don't, no. Withdraw that amendment.

PRESIDENT MOUL: Thank you, Senator Landis.

CLERK: The next amendment I have, Madam President, is by Senator Morrissey. Senator, I have AM2032 in front of me, which was the revised version. (Morrissey amendment appears on pages 2380-81 of the Legislative Journal.)

PRESIDENT MOUL: Senator Morrissey.

SENATOR MORRISSEY: Thank you, Madam President and members. I want to thank Senator Landis for withdrawing his amendment. My amendment is a fairly simple amendment, it's a tax increase of one cent on the cigarette tax to be used to establish the Solid Waste Management Fund. Would increase the cigarette tax one
