

think for \$39,000, we are getting a bargain that is not out of context with other uses of appropriations from this fund. I would encourage the adoption of the amendment.

PRESIDENT MOUL: Thank you, Senator Coordsen. We will now vote on the Coordsen amendment. All those in favor please vote aye, opposed nay. Have you all voted on the Coordsen amendment. Senator Coordsen.

PRESIDENT MOUL: Have a request for a call of the house, all those in favor please vote aye, opposed nay. Please record, Mr. Clerk.

CLERK: 16 ayes, 0 nays to go under call, Madam President.

PRESIDENT MOUL: The house is under call. Will senators please return to the Chamber and please check in. All unauthorized personnel please leave the floor. Would the senators please be seated and please record their presence. Senator Abboud, Senator Ashford, Senator Bernard-Stevens, would you please check in. Senator Cudaback, Senator Elmer, and Senator Rod Johnson, please check in. Still looking for Senator Abboud and Senator Rod Johnson. Senator Coordsen.

SENATOR COORDSEN: Have you been able to locate the two missing members?

PRESIDENT MOUL: At this point, no.

SENATOR COORDSEN: May we call the Government Committee back, Madam President? If you haven't been able to locate them, let's go ahead and take a vote. It is going to be pretty tough with no more members present but we will try.

PRESIDENT MOUL: Okay, we will proceed with a roll call vote in reverse order.

CLERK: He asked for regular.
