

SENATOR ROBINSON: What's your amendment dollarwise?

SENATOR ASHFORD: Five hundred thousand.

SENATOR ROBINSON: Where's it go?

SENATOR ASHFORD: Over the biennium. It goes to UNO.

SENATOR ROBINSON: Yes.

SENATOR ASHFORD: ..bringing this for UNO at this time.

SENATOR ROBINSON: Okay. Okay, now I think it was about the last go-round on the Appropriations Committee we...how much money did we give UNO on that last shot that you got for UNO? Didn't we give them another 250,000 dollars?

SENATOR ASHFORD: There's 500,000 in the budget over the biennium for UNO at this time, which is...

SENATOR ROBINSON: That's what we put in.

SENATOR ASHFORD: ..woefully short of what's needed.

SENATOR ROBINSON: Woefully short.

SENATOR ASHFORD: Right.

SENATOR ROBINSON: Okay, woefully short. Okay, I stand to oppose the Ashford amendment. I think we treated UNO very fairly with...in the Appropriations Committee. On the last day or so we give them I think it was 500,000, as Senator Ashford said. And, as I mentioned before, you know, that little Dutch kid that had that finger in the dike, his old hand better start swelling a little because the old dike's about ready to burst. So you can criticize Senator Moore if you want to about his
