And then, finally, because it is not a public entity but is kind of a quasi public entity, it would subject the association to the public meetings law when performing those limited functions that they would be authorized to do, such as the preparation of...of or assisting in the coordination of budget requests. Essentially technical in nature yet, hopefully, would avoid some misunderstandings that might be created with the wording that is contained in LB 663. This is just a more convenient way to make .to offer the amendment so I would move adoption of the amendment to the bill.
