SENATOR ROBINSON: We've talked about Lincoln, we've talked about Omaha, how about around the state, could we have situations like this around the state, could very easily happen, couldn't it?

SPEAKER BAACK: There may be some situations only for the next year or so where this could occur because within two years everyone has to be open to open enrollment. So this legislation only applied to districts that were closed to open enrollment for capacity, unless there is some school district in this state that may get to capacity and not accept at that point, but at this point there are none.

SENATOR ROBINSON: Okay, thank you. I do want to compliment Senator Chambers because I think he...I'm like...I'm like Senator Lynch, I forget, Senator Warner, I think this is right. I don't think it's right that all these people have to, should have to pay, but I think if it's right for Omaha, it should be right for Lincoln and I will support Senator Chambers' amendment.

SENATOR CONWAY: Thank you, Senator Robinson. There are no other lights. Senator Chambers, would you like to close on your motion? Senator Chambers waives closing. The motion before the body is to return LB 207 to Select for Senator Chambers' amendment. All in favor vote aye, against vote no. Mr. Clerk.

CLERK: 30 ayes, 0 nays, Mr. President, on adoption of the motion to return the bill.

SENATOR CONWAY: The bill is returned. Senator Chambers.

SENATOR CHAMBERS: Mr. President, I move for the adoption of the amendment that we've just discussed.

SENATOR CONWAY: The motion is to move adoption. I see no other lights. All in favor of adopting Senator Chambers' amendment vote aye if you're in favor and against vote no. Has everyone voted? Mr. Clerk.

CLERK: 36 ayes, 0 nays, Mr. President, on adoption of the amendment.

SENATOR CONWAY: The amendment is adopted. Senator Will.
