

Senator Warner's amendment to the committee amendments.

PRESIDENT MOUL: Thank you, Senator Hall. Is there anyone else who wishes to speak to the Warner amendment? Seeing none, do you have closing? Closing is waived. We will vote on the Warner amendment. All those in favor please vote aye, opposed nay. Have you all voted? Please record, Mr. Clerk.

CLERK: 18 ayes, 0 nays, Madam President, on adoption of Senator Warner's amendment.

CLERK: Senator Warner, I have now your amendment you gave me a little earlier today, "Page 147." (See FA167 on page 2432 of the Legislative Journal.)

SENATOR WARNER: This is a minor amendment. One of the provisions of the committee amendment is a report of income from the group of state agencies that have been involved in the development of the entire package, and under the provisions of that in the bill, they were to make the report, if I remember correctly, December of 1991. It delays it one year for the simple reason that much of the data that would be appropriately needed to be reported will not be available in that quick a time, should have been one year later to start with. So it is a minor one but I would move its adoption.

PRESIDENT MOUL: Thank you, Senator Warner. Does anyone wish to speak to this amendment? Seeing none, we will vote on the Warner amendment. All those in favor please vote aye, opposed nay. Have you all voted? Have you all voted? Please record, Mr. Clerk.
