But I would hope that when we get through with this that we are going to come up with a concept....I'm willing to support the concept in Senator Hall's amendment here, not because I dislike the employee number at all, but I'm willing to look at expansion of the services. I have always said that some day we would expand to services, this is selective. I don't think that will happen, but I think it's certainly a very reasonable approach if we want to go out and look for a new source of revenue, and that's what this is. But I would hope out of this, whatever we do, that we will stay with those two concepts. And those back of the glass have to accept it, too, because Senator Hall has repeatedly pointed out nobody is going to like anything that is proposed, if you have to pay it. And the one option we can't do is put it all onto property, period, which is the ultimate choice that we're really dealing with, and that, we all know, we're all opposed to making that addition. So we've got to accept something. I would hope as the evening goes along that we could jell behind one proposal, at least the majority of us can jell behind one proposal because that's what is going to be necessary. And I'm going to be...I'm fairly flexible. There is one thing I will not do, though, and that is when you get too specific, or that is industry specific, as some of the proposals that we've had, that I do not believe is fair, nor will I support some when the rate gets at some point too high.

SPEAKER BAACK: One minute.

SENATOR WARNER: Equity in taxation, we all can af...There is no tax that's fair. And we can all accept an unfair tax until that rate becomes, at some point we consider excessive. Certainly when we get to the surcharge on personal...on personal property, on the depreciation schedule, I'm not sure that I care to go to three; two was acceptable to me. But at some point that, too, can become too high, and then it's unacceptable. And I just hope that we'll keep this in mind that we are going to come up with an agreement of generating the money that fits the concepts that we started out with. Senator Hall's concept here I can support.

SPEAKER BAACK: Time.
