

provide more of these types of information to the industry. But, Senator Moore, I'm not going to offer that amendment to the budget this year. Maybe next year. The issue though is really one of protecting the consumer ultimately and you do that by getting to the root of the problem. If the companies have the ability to make good decisions prior to hire with regard to these individuals, there will be fewer complaints that are filed and there will be probably a lot more used car salesmen than there are insurance agents. With that, I would urge adoption of the amendment.

SPEAKER BAACK: You've heard Senator Hall's closing on his amendment. We will now vote on the amendment. All those in favor vote aye, opposed vote no. We are voting on the amendment by Senator Hall. Have you all voted? Have you all voted? Record, Mr. Clerk.
