

the bill right there. I've already described compostable. It can be almost anything that presently exists, presently exists, because we don't know what humus-like material is. And on down it says on or after October 1, 1993, a person shall not sell or offer for sale at retail any disposable diaper which is constructed of a material which is not compostable, biodegradable or photodegradable, or any disposable diaper which cannot be composted in a solid waste composting facility. Senator Hefner, that doesn't say "and" degradable, biodegradable. It says "or", compostable or biodegradable. You are to pass this bill, to move this bill, in my opinion, under these definitions you are hurting the corn industry, you are hurting the Corn Growers and if they look at it, look at it again, I think they may agree. And that's why I'm doing this. I'm not doing it for any other reason. It's a bad bill the way it's written. We shouldn't be talking about it. We shouldn't be talking about it now. It should be studied and it should be studied on the proper procedure on three levels. I should have offered the bracket right away. I'm sorry. I'm just doing what I think is right and I really don't want to and I won't maybe next year. I'll let you do it, Senator Hefner. I'll let you fight the plastics industry on one stage of debate instead of two, because it's not easy to beat them. It's not easy to beat them. I say let's bracket it and get on to more important matters. I am sorry we spent this much time on it, but I just can't let it go. I just can't let it go, and I keep...we very seldom get a bill, that's technically flawed, allowed to move forward because we're going to address it again. That question is often brought up and it delays bills all the time and I can't understand why this one is any different. A lot of definitions that are up in the air have no idea what they mean. Let's bracket it and move on to the more important matters.
