SPEAKER BAACK: Thank you, Senator Ashford. Seeing no other lights on, Senator Rod Johnson, would you like to close?

SENATOR R. JOHNSON: Mr. Speaker, I would move the advancement of the bill.

SPEAKER BAACK: You've heard the closing. We will now vote on the advancement of LB 669. All those in favor vote aye, opposed vote no. We are voting on the advancement of LB 669. Have you all voted? Record, Mr. Clerk.

CLERK: 26 ayes, 6 nays, Mr. President, on the advancement of 669.

SPEAKER BAACK: LB 669 advances. Do you have items for the record, Mr. Clerk?

CLERK: Not at this time, Mr. President.

SPEAKER BAACK: Okay, we will proceed to Item 9 on the agenda, General File. LB 470.

CLERK: LB 470, Mr. President, is a bill introduced by Senator Schmit. (Read title.) The bill was referred to the Banking Committee. Banking Committee reported the bill to General File. Committee amendments have been adopted, Mr. President, on April 9. The bill was discussed again on May 15. Senator Landis has amendments to the bill that were adopted, as did Senator Schmit.

SPEAKER BAACK: Senator Schmit, to give us an update on the bill.

SENATOR SCHMIT: Mr. President and members, LB 470 is a bill which has been debated before on this floor, and has been amended, and which I believe today should not take a lot of time. We either have the votes to move the bill, or we do not. In order to brief you on the bill again I would just like to say that the bill, as amended, strikes the 25-mile provision that
