

SENATOR SCHIMEK: Yes, Madam President and members of the body, this amendment is printed on page 2374 of the Journal, and it simply, the first part of it asks that the reimbursement rate be established equal to the Medicare rate which currently is \$55. This is for the screening program. And, second, that the clean-up...that the clean-up language in the second part of it, 403, I believe it is, be changed to 405, and 474 be changed to 494. These are just citations from the Federal Register and they needed to be changed to be proper.
