LB 830, 830A

PRESIDENT MOUL: Thank you, Senator Wesely. You've heard the motion to advance LB 830. All those in favor please say aye. Opposed nay. LB 830 is advanced. LB 830A.

CLERK: Madam President, 830A, no Enrollment and Review amendments. I do have an amendment to the bill from Senator Wesely. (See AM1981 on pages 2477-78 of the Legislative Journal.)

SENATOR WESELY: Thank you. Madam President, this amendment is brought to me by the Fiscal Office. It deals...

SENATOR WESELY: It deals with the case management issue. The original bill called for 65,000 in General Fund. I believe this goes to 95,000 in General Fund. And then...oh, and then it makes...that's right, this is the one that makes the changes that reflect the other issue that we had earlier that we dealt with on the budget bill. So it is mostly a funds transfer issue that doesn't really affect any of the actual expenditures, as I understand it. Move for adoption of the amendment.

PRESIDENT MOUL: Thank you, Senator Wesely. You've heard the motion. Does anyone wish to speak to this amendment? Seeing none, we will vote on the motion to adopt the Wesely amendment. All those in favor please vote aye, opposed nay. Have you all voted on the Wesely amendment? Please record, Mr. Clerk.

CLERK: 25 ayes, 0 nays, Madam President, on adoption of Senator Wesely's amendment.
