**SPEAKER BAACK:** All provisions of law relative to procedure having been complied with, the question is, shall LB 720 with the emergency clause attached pass? All those in favor vote aye, opposed vote no. Have you all voted? Record, Mr. Clerk.

**CLERK:** (Record vote read. See page 2500 of the Legislative Journal.) 42 ayes, 0 nays, 1 present and not voting, 6 excused and not voting, Mr. President.

**SPEAKER BAACK:** LB 720 with the emergency clause attached passes. We'll now go to LB 840.

**ASSISTANT CLERK:** (Read LB 840 on Final Reading.)

**SPEAKER BAACK:** All provisions of law relative to procedure having been complied with, the question is, shall LB 425 pass? All those in favor vote aye, opposed vote no. Have you all voted? Record, Mr. Clerk.

**CLERK:** (Record vote read. See pages 2501-02 of the Legislative Journal.) 33 ayes, 12 nays, 4 excused and not voting, Mr. President.

**SPEAKER BAACK:** LB 425 passes. We will now proceed to Item 6...or Item 7 on the agenda, a special order bill of Senator Moore's. Items for the record, Mr. Clerk?
